## D harmonica country tuned





This Charlie McCoy harmonica solo follows the melody of the song fairly closely. To play this solo as written you will need a diatonic (10 hole) harmonica in te key of D and play in crossharp. This means that your home scale will be based on the 2 hole draw. The other detail needed to play this exactly is to have your harmonica "Country Tuned". This simply means that the 5 hole draw is raised one half step to the major seventh degree of the scale.

Harp TAB key:

ex: 3 = draw note

3+ = blow note

4' = draw bend downward 1/2 step
