The song “Boogie” by Little Walter is a harmonica tour de force on the lower end of the harp. It is played on the first 3 holes of the key of A diatonic harmonica. This great harmonica melody incorporates lot's of bending of notes so you'll need to have your note bending together!

-2 -2// -1

Harmonica Tab Legend

-2 = draw note
1 = blow note

-2/ = bend down ½ step or 1 semi tone
-2// = bend down a full step or 2 semi tones
