



My Favorite Little Walter harmonica Riff

Little Walter is one of the main starting points of the amplified blues harp sound. His style is what the majority of modern blues harmonica players have built upon. The riff presented here is one of my favorite Little Walter harmonica riffs. It's easy to play and uses mostly draw notes in the middle of the harmonica.

Harmonica Tab Legend

-2 = draw note
1 = blow note

-2/ = bend down ½ step or 1 semi tone
-2// = bend down a full step or 2 semi tones

-3// -3 -4 5 -5 -4 5 -4

Try using this riff as a starting point for a longer riff that you play.
