Tom Petty's song Mary Jane's Last Dance was released in 1993 and is still very popular today. It is a well crafted song that features a simple yet very effective harmonica part.

The tuning of the song on the recording is somewhere between A minor and Bb minor. Most likely because that's how the band had their instruments tuned or it could have happened during the mastering process. At any rate we will be playing the song in A minor on a G diatonic harmonica in third position.
